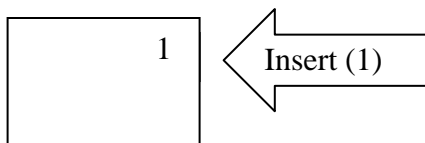


SPECIAL MEMORY BOOK PAGES

Again we will be asking you to make a Memory Book of special memories, to be submitted from **ALL** members in the Department of California. You can prepare the 12 x12 page yourself, or send the pictures along with the story, and I will complete the page(s) of your special memories to put in President Sue's book. Please try to send those to me as you complete them so they can be put into a book of Special Memories for Sue. These memories can be from the past to the present. If you have a picture or a memory of Sue when she first joined the Ladies Auxiliary, which is a special memory for her, please submit it. Another when she was installed as the Department Guard and winning that position. Just think of all the memories you have of Sue. So, think and send. What a wonderful gift this will be if you submit photos. On the back of the photo please number in upper right hand corner, and attach a separate piece of paper with the description. Remember to identify individuals from left to right. I have, for your information, set forth an example of submitting photos to the Department, without mounting them on a 12 x 12 scrapbook page. This hopefully will assist new Historians in their work, and give them instructions on how to submit photos. The first part deals with the photo itself. Take a good clear photograph, turn it over and write in the upper right hand corner a number. Use a Sharpie pen (fine point) to write the number. Do not press hard to write the number. Once done, go to a blank sheet of paper and write the number again let's say number (1) and describe the photo.

Example: **Back of Photo Number appears in upper right corner.**



On a separate sheet of paper:
